INFORMATION CLAUSE

In accordance with art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data - General Data Protection Regulation (Journal of Laws EU L 119/1 of 4 May 2016 - "GDPR") the Warsaw University of Technology informs that:

1. *The administrator of your personal data is the Warsaw University of Technology with headquarters at 1 Pl. Politechniki, 00-661 Warsaw.*
2. *The administrator has appointed a Data Protection Officer supervising the correctness of personal data processing, who can be contacted at the following email address: iod@pw.edu.pl.*
3. *Your personal data will be processed in order to conduct the survey "Monitoring the Careers of WUT Alumni" - the legal basis for processing your personal data being Art. 6 clause 1 point a GDPR;*
4. *The administrator will be processing personal data regarding: name, surname, e-mail address, student record number.*
5. *The Warsaw University of Technology does not intend to transfer your data outside the European Economic Area.*
6. *You have the right to access your personal data and the right to rectify it, the right to request deletion,*

restrict processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object to data processing, the right to withdraw consent at any time without giving a reason, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal.
